#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- **1.** Go to hsu.edu/apply and select the undergraduate application.
- 2. Create your personal profile.
- 3. Log in to complete the application.
- **4.** Submit your ACT/SAT test scores and high school transcripts.

## 2022-2023 ADMISSIONS STANDARDS

#### **TEST OPTIONAL\***

2.5+ cumulative high school GPA

#### **UNCONDITIONAL ADMISSION**

20+ Superscore ACT (or SAT equivalent) **or** 19 Superscore ACT and 3.25+ cumulative high school GPA

## **CONDITIONAL ADMISSION**

16-19 Superscore ACT (or SAT equivalent)

\*ALL students will still be required to submit ACT, SAT, or Accuplacer Next Gen test scores for placement purposes only.

#### **APPLY BEFORE JULY 1**

In order to be considered for an academic scholarship, complete your application before July 1 for fall entry.



## TRANSFER ADMISSIONS

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- **1.** Go to hsu.edu/apply and select the transfer application.
- 2. Create your personal profile.
- 3. Log in to complete the application.
- **4.** Submit official transcripts from all institutions you have attended.

with a 2.0/+ transferable GPA.

### 11/- Transferable Credit Hours

will be required to meet freshman admissions standards.

We will use your final transfer GPA to make sure you are awarded the scholarship that aligns with your information. Students with 11/- TCH will be evaluated for freshman academic scholarships and must submit required documents for evaluation process.
