FULL MEMBERSHIP:

Full membership may be granted to HSU faculty holding to the rank of Assistant Professor.

Applicants should have demonstrated professional achievement in teaching and scholarship and hold a terminal degree(s) appropriate to his or her teaching field as determined by his/her department. Members are expected to engage actively in the graduate program of the University and to pursue professional activities consistent with that participation. Membership allows a faculty member all rights and privileges associated with graduate faculty status.

ASSOCIATE PLUS MEMBERSHIP:

Associate Plus Membership, for three years, may be granted an applicant who has taught in an adjunct capacity at HSU; has successful teaching experience as demonstrated by student evaluations and recommendation of chair. Appointments may be renewed.

Persons applying for associate plus membership should hold graduate degree(s) appropriate to his or her teaching field as determined by the appropriate department. Evidence of professional achievement and/or promise in teaching and scholarship should be presented. Membership allows a faculty member all rights and privileges associated with graduate faculty status. During the period of appointment, the associate plus member may engage in the normal activities of a member of the graduate faculty.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP:

Associate membership for one year may be granted an applicant who will teach in an adjunct capacity. Appointments may be renewed.

Persons applying for associate membership should hold graduate degree(s) appropriate to his or her teaching field as determined by the appropriate department. Evidence of professional achievement and/or promise in teaching and scholarship should be presented. Membership allows a faculty member all rights and privileges associated with graduate faculty status. During the period of appointment, the associate member may engage in the normal activities of a member of the graduate faculty.

At the conclusion of the initial membership, application for a three-year associate plus membership may be initiated.

DIRECTIONS:

1. Application must be received by the Graduate School Office by the first of the month for action that month.
2. Incomplete applications will not be considered by the Graduate Council.
3. Additions to the listed courses require a memo from the Chairperson/Administrator to the Graduate Dean.
