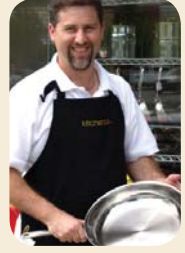

Registration and Fees: Seminar fees may be paid by check, cash, money order, or credit card (Visa, MasterCard). Payment must be received before your space is guaranteed in a class. Fee must be remitted no later than three working days before the actual seminar date unless otherwise stated.

Refund Policy: Refunds are available on cancellations received up to 48 hours prior to seminar. If a 48-hour cancellation notice is not received, seminar credit can be applied to another ASBTDC seminar within the current calendar year. If the ASBTDC cancels a seminar, notification will be sent by e-mail and refunds will be issued. Substitutes are welcome.
