Directed History Elective Courses

In addition to the 15 hour core of required history courses, history majors must further take 18 hours of directed history elective courses. For course availability, consult the Social Sciences Department semester course rotation pamphlet and the current Henderson undergraduate catalogue.

Foreign Language Requirement

Students must complete six hours in intermediate level or above of a principal modern foreign language.

Liberal Arts Core Courses

History majors must satisfy the University's liberal arts core requirements, as stipulated in the Henderson undergraduate catalogue.

Students majoring in history must also complete the requirements for a minor in another field of study.
