Non-Western Music can be used to fulfill the non-western requirement in the liberal arts core.

A total of 120 hours are required to graduate, including a minimum of 42 upper level hours.

Note: Applied Lessons and Performance Lab are required during every semester of full-time study, regardless of minimum number of classes required. Major Ensemble is required for the first 6 semesters of full-time study.
