## **Required Courses**

HIS 2053	United States to 1877
HIS 2063	United States since 1877

## **Directed History Elective Courses**

In addition to the 12 hour core of required history courses, history minors must further take 6 hours of directed history elective courses. For course availability, consult the Social Sciences Department semester course rotation pamphlet and the current Henderson undergraduate catalogue.

#### **Liberal Arts Core Courses**

History minors must satisfy the University's liberal arts core requirements, as stipulated in the Henderson undergraduate catalogue.

## **Major**

Students minoring in history must also fulfill the requirements for a major in another field of study.

All Henderson undergraduate students must complete at least one writing intensive (WI) course in the major to be eligible for graduation.
